



Celebrate National Trails Day at the Mandala Center!

JOIN US on National Trails Day in the grand adventure of hiking to the top of Sierra Grande, the most unique extinct shield volcano in the area. You will climb 2,200 feet above the plains and walk on 2.5-million-year-old rocks made of two-pyroxene andesite. Sierra Grande is one of the few places where both pyroxene groups occur in the same rock.



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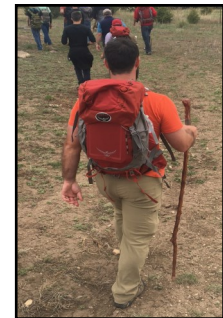
The View from the Top will be Spectacular!
